- Managed to get agencies together (At strategic level)
- Aligned service priorities across agencies.
- Less successful at a lower/operational level.
- Safeguarding improvements across District councils, colleges etc.....clear processes etc
- Relationships improved which in turn improved partnership arrangements
- Shared priorities/performance/accountability across agencies.
- Partnership needs to better understand limitations and objectives of each agency.
- There is a CYP Plan
- We lost our way, but recent meetings have been an improvement
- Got partners around the table.
- Able to communicate plans
- Sharing and informing the direction of travel.
- Over the last year, involvement has appeared to decrease. There has been a loss in momentum as result of LCC changes.
- Task/Finish is seen as a way forward TAC/CAF, Children's Centre – achievements gained. District Council involvements.

How should we identify our priorities?

Notes / Comments

- Services still need to be aligned
- We still need to be Outcome focused – consult with agencies, localities, young people.
- Alongside each agencies national priorities.
- Using a Performance Framework/Quality Assurance Framework
- By linking with other strategic partnerships.
- How do we share information between partners – (and avoid Bureaucracy)
- Shouldn't 'swap & change' – some priorities need long term commitment.
- Has to be informed.
- Has to be evaluated.
- Needs an evidence base
- Look at previous plans – what are the main issues for our partners?

- Asset mapping/ Asset transfer eg. Buildings
- Community engagement/development
- Health and Well-Being Strategy
- JSNA
- Engagement with children & young people/ parents/ carers etc
- Keep it strategic
- Vulnerability of young people
- The Childs journey

- NEET'S
- Prevention/Early Intervention
- Maximising resources across all agencies to improve outcomes.
(Focus on Families, child centres. Parenting (probation/YOS links into parents of future offenders).
- Safeguarding – How we fit with LSCB?
- Joint/shared training – Ensuring front line staff equipped to take the CYP Plan forward
- CYPSP should be the hub for people to deposit info and allow partners to identify priorities (e.g. through inspection.)
- Communication/dissemination
- Engaging the correct individuals – at the right level
- Engaging communities/Big society
- Encouraging communities to do more for themselves i.e. support Targeted & vulnerable population
- Equity
- Identifying the KPI's that we want to change together
- Preparation of workforce for future working

- “So what” approach? Need to measures/Outcome focused?
- Is it the Strategic Board’s duty to produce data?
- Should we actually do that?
- Broad themes direction of travel.
- Must have mechanism to do something about key areas where outcomes are poor e.g. Task & Finish Groups
- Must have membership who can (are empowered) to make a decision
- Score Cards
- Monitoring outcomes
- Renewing data collection
- Voice of families/ User groups
- Milestones to ensure that reporting is not annually
- Depends on the way the priority is described. Quantifiable output/outcomes?
- The Task & Finish group should accept accountability to deliver and evaluate output/outcomes. Exception reporting to strategy/coordinating group if required.
