


Multi Agency Inspection 2013



Background

CRA inspections

assess the effectiveness of all front-line practice in managing potential risks to children and young people and to minimise the incidence of abuse and neglect

Interim CP inspection

key aspects of a child's journey through the child protection system, focusing on the experiences of the child or young person, and the effectiveness of the help and protection that they are offered

Multiagency inspection

The experiences of CYP, the effectiveness of help and protection they receive and the <u>quality</u> of practice that protects them

Key Changes

- June 2013
- 3 Year Cycle (New)
- Unannounced
- > 2 weeks on site
- 4 key judgements

One single judgement/one single report



- No Focus Groups
- Voice of the Child & The Childs Journey
- Observation of Practice
- SCR/shared Case File Analysis and tracking
- Engagement with Service Users
- Learning Opportunities
- Risk Management
- Early Help
- Collaborative Working
