BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The County Council is intending to undertake a review of the provision and operation of Household Waste Recycling Centres during 2010/11.

The review will be in the context of both the progress that has been made in meeting recycling and diversion targets as well as the changed economic circumstances now applicable to local government.

DISCUSSIONS

The review is intended to be wide-ranging and will include the following areas;

- Level of provision;
- Opening times;
- Enforcement activity;
- Contract arrangements;
- Waste streams to be handled;
- Salvage contracts;
- Third party collection facilities;
- Signage;
- Health and Safety.

The County Council is inviting partner organisations on the Lincolnshire Waste

Partnership to participate in the review process, and as such are requested to consider initial responses for submission to LCC officers.

The Waste Partnership is also requested to indicate what additional information may be required to assist individual partners to respond to the process.

The Partnership is asked to indicate any other areas they would wish to see included in the review.

- i) Note the contents of the report and consider initial responses;
- ii) Indicate any other areas for possible inclusion in the review;
- iii) Request any additional information that may be required to assist individual partners to respond to the review;
