KA6	Illegal Use of PROW	Joint initiative with Humberside Police & Parish Councils to alleviate issues with illegal use by motorbikes & quad bikes.	Horse-friendly gates now installed at 3 key locations to prevent illegal use of PROWs by motorbikes and off-road jeeps. Reports received that they have been successful with no complaints by legitimate users.
KA 06 & KA08 & KA12	Safer Road Crossings	Joint partnership project with road safety team to improve exit points onto busy A road and installation of information promotional boards.	Road safety audit and investigation being undertaken with regards to Public Right of Way crossing over Stallingborough Interchange to coincide with plans to provide new link road to Immingham dock. The report is expected to provide options to improve the route.
KA2 & KA9 & KA11 & KA12 & KA13	Strategic Urban Path Improvement Plan	Project to deliver surface upgrades to existing well used paths in the urban area.	Improvement works to upgrade surface on 2 key, well used routes within Stallingborough and Brigsley (Wanderlust Way) have been completed.
KA01 & KA03	Reinstatement of FP72	Ongoing legal issues to determine accurate line of FP72 requiring amendment to Definitive Map and reinstatement of path on the ground.	The initial DMMO, being one of 2 legal orders required in relation to this footpath has now been confirmed as unopposed. The other order (PPO) received objections during advertisement, and these are now being considered by the Council's Legal Services. Preliminary informal consultation undertaken with the land owners on minor modifications to route intended to address objections received. Draft report to Planning Committee to seek authorisation to re-make PPO being prepared with a view to submitting to Committee in August.
KA03, KA5	Unavailable Paths Project	To identify routes recorded on the Def Map that are blocked/obstructed and arrange for the necessary works/action to re-open them.	Enforcement action planned against landowner currently obstructing FP89 Ashby Cum Fenby in order to reinstate use.
KA1, KA2, KA3 & KA4	Definitive Map Issues	Address legal deficiencies with a view to eventually producing an up to date Consolidation Map.	The backlog of LEMOs for a total of 114 Legal Orders affecting the Definitive Map for North East Lincolnshire has now been addressed resulting in 4 bulk orders, bringing ALL historical order making up to date.
