It is therefore recommended that SACRE sends congratulatory letters to Hartsholme primary School, St Helena's CE Primary School, the National CE Junior School, Grantham, the Tydd St Mary CE Primary School, the Skegness Grammar School and the St Francis Special School.

Schools where SMSC and/or Community Cohesion are key issues for improvement

1. Weston St Mary CE Primary School

The school should broaden pupils' experiences of the world by establishing links with other schools with contrasting characteristics within this country and abroad.

2. Ingoldsby Primary School

The school should improve its support for community cohesion by:

- providing more opportunities in the curriculum for pupils to learn about the diversity of faiths and cultures in the world
- creating links with contrasting organisations in this country and further afield

3. Lincoln Birchwood Junior School

The school should increase pupils' understanding of their place in the wider community by:

- seeking ways to increase pupils' contribution to the community beyond the school
- providing opportunities for pupils to have first-hand interaction with their counterparts in a contrasting community

4. Binbrook CE Primary School

The school should improve the effectiveness with which it promotes community cohesion, by providing pupils with better opportunities to learn both with and about others from differing religious, ethnic and socio-economic backgrounds.

5. The Saint Thomas CE Primary School, Boston

The school should improve the curriculum by providing more opportunities for pupils to gain an understanding of cultural diversity.

6. Ruskington Chestnut Street CE Primary School

The school should develop pupils' understanding of the diversity in British society by:

- providing them with more opportunities to interact with others from different ethnic, religious and socio-economic backgrounds that are representative of the different groups within the United Kingdom
- regularly monitoring and evaluating the impact of these opportunities on pupils' understanding of cultural diversity.

During this period one primary school received a subject inspection for RE and the overall effectiveness was judged to be good.
