Lincolnshire Coastal Country Park
Public Rights of Way Alteration Proposals

Robin Carr Associates is in receipt of instructions from Lincolnshire County Council to undertake a package of work which seeks to implement a number of changes to the public rights of way network within the Huttoft and Anderby area. These are being pursued as part of the Lincolnshire Coastal Country Park project, summary details of which are enclosed.

We have recently concluded discussions with the various land owners affected by the proposals with a view to seeking their agreement to the changes. To this end please find attached a number of plans showing the proposals that have where land owner agreement has been secured.

The next stage of the process is to give interested parties the opportunity to submit any comments on the proposals and indicate whether or not they support them. Once the consultation exercise has been completed, each proposals proposal will be assessed against the relevant legislative criteria after which we will prepare an advisory report to assist the County Council in making a decision whether or not to proceed with each proposal to Order Making stage.

To this end I should like to invite you to submit and comments, representations and indications of support or objection within 6 weeks of the date of this letter. If you do propose to object to any proposal I should be obliged if you would indicate the grounds upon which the objection is made, and also any changes or amendments to the proposal which may assist in securing the withdrawal of the objection.

To assist with consultation responses, I have enclosed a pro-forma consultation form for each proposal should you wish to make use of it. If you prefer you are, of course, are welcome to respond by way of email or a letter, however I should request that comments on each proposal be clearly identified on a path by path basis. Please ensure that responses to this consultation are sent direct to me and not to the County Council. You can however be assured that the County Council will receive copies of all responses as part of our reporting process. Such responses may also be in the public domain in due course.
