| Subject:   | Changes to the Terms of Reference of SACRE |

**Summary:** To report revisions to the SACRE's Constitution in connection with the appointment of Local Authority representatives.

### Recommendation

That the report be noted.

#### Background

The SACRE considered its new constitution on 23 June 2015, and it was subsequently approved by Councillor Mrs P A Bradwell, Executive Councillor for Adult Care, Health and Children's Services. However, since being approved a revision is required.

Under "Membership" it states that "Committee D: the LA: to be politically balanced". The need for the Local Authority representatives to be politically balanced is not a requirement under the provisions of the Education Act 1996, which places a duty on Local Authorities to establish a SACRE. The position now is that, having reflected on the position the County Council wishes to propose a revision to the Constitution in the interests of "Committee D" being able to be appointed to more easily. It will be necessary for the Executive Councillor for Adult Care, Health and Children's Services to approve these revisions to the SACRE's Constitution.
