SCRUTINY COMMENTS

COUNCIL BUSINESS PLAN 2016-2017 PERFORMANCE REPORT, QUARTER THREE

The Overview and Scrutiny Management Committee met on 23 February 2017 and considered a report concerning the Council Business Plan 2016-2017 Performance Report, Quarter Three. The Committee agreed to pass on the following comments to the Executive as part of the consideration of this item.

- In relation to the measure "permanent admissions to residential and nursing care homes aged 65+", a Councillor highlighted that they had been made aware that a number of nursing homes were deregistering as nursing homes to become residential homes, which meant that there would be a reduction in the number of available beds in nursing homes. It was queried whether the figures for this measure could be separated out for admissions to residential homes and admissions to nursing homes to obtain a clearer picture and see whether the loss of nursing homes was having an impact on the target.
- In relation to the measure "high risk premises visited by Trading Standards", it was queried what was meant by high risk premises and whether it included illegal alcohol premises. It was noted that this was mainly in relation to food premises which had been categorised by the Food Standards Agency, DEFRA and the Better Regulation Delivery Office as needing an annual compliance visit. With regards to whether illegal alcohol premises were included in this measure, it was agreed that this would be clarified and reported back to the Committee.

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
