Peppermint Park Food Enterprise Zone Decision Date: 2 March 2018

Comments from the Environment and Economy Scrutiny Committee

The Environment and Economy Scrutiny Committee considered a report on the Peppermint Park Food Enterprise Zone on 27 February 2018 and agreed to support the recommendation to the Executive Councillor for Economy and Place.

The Committee endorsed the approach of the Council in investing in a project to develop a Centre of Excellence for Food Technology and opening up land for development. The Committee also supported the plan to recoup a substantial amount of the initial investment through the sale of the land sell to developers and/or owner occupiers at market value.
