Comments of the Adults and Community Wellbeing Scrutiny Committee

On 11 April 2018, the Adults and Community Wellbeing Scrutiny Committee agreed to support the three recommendations to the Executive Councillor for Adult Care, Health and Children's Services on the NHS Health Checks Re-procurement.

The Committee commented that it would be beneficial if the outcomes from the health checks programme could be analysed to see anything further could be learned, for example in terms of lifestyle choices.

The Committee was advised that the health check programme tended to avoid duplication, so where individuals were already in receipt of regular health monitoring for certain conditions, such as diabetes or a cardiovascular condition, they would not be invited for a health check.
