SCRUTINY COMMENTS

A17-A15 Holdingham Roundabout and A17-A153 Rugby Club Junction, Sleaford

The Highways and Transport Scrutiny Committee met on 11 March 2019 and considered a report on the A17-A15 Holdingham Roundabout and A17-A153 Rugby Club Junction, Sleaford.

The Committee supported the recommendations to the Leader of the County Council and Executive Councillor for Highways, Transport and IT and agreed to pass on the following comments as part of their consideration of this item.

- The Committee supported the delivery of changes to the A17/A15 Holdingham Roundabout and A17/A153 Rugby Club Junction and recommended that detailed consideration was given to ensure the design of the scheme is effective, includes clear advanced signage and road markings to improve road safety.
- The Committee highlighted the proposed changes to the Rugby Club junction and recommended that the traffic modelling work considered the impact on the A153 and ensure the location of large local businesses and peak shift working patterns were included to provide the most accurate traffic model.
- The Committee supported the proposal to procure both improvements as one contract to reduce costs and manage the temporary traffic management provisions as one package. The Committee highlighted the need to ensure good communication and forward planning in order to reduce network disruption during the works.
- The Committee highlighted the need to consider how the section 106 contributions were recovered should the level of required development not have taken place within 15 years after the completion of the works. Officers confirmed a memorandum of understanding with North Kesteven District Council was being drawn up to address these concerns.
