**Summary:**

To receive a presentation on the proposed flood risk improvement scheme in the Keeble Drive area of Washingborough.

**1. Background**

The Keeble Drive area of Washingborough has a history of flooding from surface water. This is typically caused by intense rainfall events, for which the drainage system is under capacity. In addition the estate is located on a steep gradient, but outfalls into an almost-level watercourse. This causes the system to back-up and cause further flooding. The proposed scheme reduces the risk of flooding to these properties.
