BETWEEN:

1. **Lincolnshire County Council** of County Offices, Newland, Lincoln LN1 1YL ("LCC")

and

2. **NHS Lincolnshire West Clinical Commissioning Group**, Cross O Cliff Court, Lincoln, LN4 2HN ("West CCG"), **NHS South West Lincolnshire Clinical Commissioning Group**, South Kesteven District Council Offices, St Peter's Hill, Grantham. NG31 6PZ ("South West CCG"), **NHS South Lincolnshire Clinical Commissioning Group**, Stamford & Rutland Hospital, Ryhall Road, Stamford, PE9 1UA ("South CCG") and **NHS Lincolnshire East Clinical Commissioning Group**, Cross O Cliff Court, Lincoln, LN4 2HN ("East CCG") (together, the "CCGs")

WHEREAS:

1. There is a need to improve the quality of life of the people who live and work in Lincolnshire.
2. LCC and the CCGs wish to provide for that need by delivering, supporting and promoting health and social care activities (the "Project").
3. Appropriate delivery of the Project shall be managed through the Health & Wellbeing Board or sub-group thereof (the 'Board').

IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Aims of the Project

1.1 To improve the health, economic, social and environmental wellbeing of the people who live and work in Lincolnshire by addressing the themes of the Joint Health & Wellbeing Strategy and through this Agreement's original aims of:

- (i) addressing the health and social inequalities that exist in some populations;
- (ii) addressing low incomes by enhancing the employment prospects, education and skills of local people, particularly the young and those at a disadvantage, and promote equality of opportunity;
- (iii) improving housing and housing conditions for local people through physical improvements, better maintenance, improved management and greater choice and diversity;

- (iv) enhancing the quality of life and capacity to contribute to local regeneration of local people, including their health and cultural and sports opportunities; and
- (v) supporting people to improve their lifestyles in ways likely to be of benefit to themselves and others.

2. Objectives

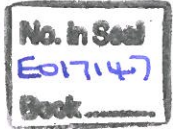
2.1 The overall objectives of the Project and Board are:

- 2.1.1 To determine whether to fund project applications and oversee the successful delivery of those projects to deliver improved health and well-being in Lincolnshire.
- 2.1.2 To monitor the impact of the funded projects on the quality of life of the local community in Lincolnshire.

3. Organisational Arrangements

3.1 LCC shall provide the Secretariat and be responsible for the administration of the Fund through the office of Public Health whose duties shall include but is not limited to:

- (i) provide any information reasonably required by the Board so as to enable the Board to make a recommendation in respect of any funding under this Agreement;
- (ii) provide information in relation to any proposed projects to which funding may be allocated; and
- (iii) prepare and complete an annual review (completed within 2 months of the end of the financial year) detailing the effectiveness of the Project
