Subject:	<b>Updated JSNA Overview Report 2013/14</b>

**Summary:**

Each year a JSNA overview report for Lincolnshire is produced, this summarises the key changes that have taken place within the JSNA evidence base over the last 12 months. The latest version of the JSNA overview report is included as an appendix to this paper.

**Actions Required:**

Health and Wellbeing Board members are asked to read the JSNA overview report and consider the implications of the information held within it.

**1. Background**

The first JSNA overview report written in 2011 made a commitment to producing annual update reports to be viewed alongside the wider JSNA data sets and commentaries. This year the overview report has been produced in a slightly different way to previous years; the executive summaries from all JSNA topic commentaries that have been updated throughout 2013/14 have been extracted and used to make up the body of the document.

It should also be noted that a full review of the JSNA processes and working arrangements is currently underway; this will be the subject of a future board report.

## 2. Conclusion

The JSNA overview report should be read in conjunction with the wider JSNA data sets and commentaries. The aim of this report is to establish what has changed within the JSNA over the course of the year and what impact this should have on the future direction of the JSNA in terms of new topics to be added or amendments to existing topics. It is also important that local commissioning decisions make full use of the evidence based captured within the JSNA.

As in previous years an 'easy read' version of the JSNA overview report has also been produced and is available on the JSNA area of the Lincolnshire Research Observatory.
