Proposal to amend the age range at Grantham Belton Lane Community Primary School from 3–11 years to 4–11 years.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in accordance with section 19(3) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Lincolnshire County Council, County Offices, Newland, Lincoln LN1 1YQ intends to make a prescribed alteration to Belton Lane Community Primary School, Green Lane, Grantham NG31 9PP with effect from 31 August 2012.

The prescribed alteration is to amend the age range from 3–11 years to 4–11 years and therefore remove the Local Authority nursery provision at the school. The designated nursery class has been temporarily closed for two years. The Local Authority is making this proposal to fulfil its statutory duty of maintaining a sufficiency of early years places and following this alteration there will be adequate provision of early years places in Grantham. The net capacity of the school will not be affected by this proposal and the Published Admission Number will remain at 30.
