Subject: Fostering Services Statement of Purpose

Summary:

The purpose of this report is to inform Members about the work of the Fostering Service in accordance with the requirements of the Care Standards Act 2000, Fostering Services Regulations 2002, 2011, and Fostering Services National Minimum Standards 2010 to provide a clear, written Statement of Purpose setting out the aims and objectives of the Fostering Service and what facilities and services they provide.

The report sets out the relevant performance information and identifies the key developments within the service over the last twelve months 2010/2011.

Recommendation(s):

The Executive Councillor is recommended to approve the Statement of Purpose.

Reasons for Recommendation:

The Statement of Purpose is a requirement under the Regulations and Standards which form the basis of the regulatory framework, The Care Standards Act 2000. Approval of the Statement of Purpose will achieve compliance with National Minimum Standards and the Regulations applicable to Local Authority Fostering Services.

Not to approve the Statement of Purpose will put the local authority in breach of the regulatory requirement.

1. Background

In recognition of the highly specialised nature of Fostering, Lincolnshire Children's Services operate a discrete Fostering Service, on a countywide basis from three localities. This Statement of Purpose thus presents the performance of the service to the Executive Committee, Portfolio Holder and Elected Members.

2. Conclusion

The report attached at Appendix A contains a range of information about the Fostering Service in relation to performance indicators and measuring good outcomes; the work of the Fostering Service; and various regulations relating to the Fostering Service. The Statement of Purpose fulfils the requirements of Standard 1 of the Fostering Services Minimum Standards (Care Standards Act 2000) and Regulations 3 and 4 of the Fostering Services Regulations, 2002, 2011.

The report when approved will be placed on the Lincolnshire County Council Fostering website. Members of the Fostering Panel and staff working in the Fostering Service have been consulted.
