

Proposal to Develop a Sixth Form at Sir William Robertson High School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(3) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that The Governing Body of Sir William Robertson High School intends to make a prescribed alteration to Sir William Robertson High School (Foundation School) Main Road Welbourn Lincoln LN5 0PA from 01 September 2012.

The Governing Body proposes to establish a sixth form for 200 students on the existing school site. This is intended to build upon the school's existing strong academic credentials and meet demand from students, parents and the local community. The school is currently the largest mixed 11-16 foundation school in Lincolnshire, with no other secondary school or college within a significant driving distance of the school. The Governing Body wish to extend the age range to 11-18 to ease the transition of its students to post-16 courses and to allow the school to meet the requirements of Raising of the Participation Age.

The current capacity of the school is 838 and the proposed capacity will be 838. The current admission number for the school is 170 and the proposed admission number will be 170.

It is proposed that the implementation of the sixth form will be completed in four stages. There will be 60 Year 12 places for September 2012; 80 Year 12 places for September 2013; 100 Year 12 places for September 2014; and 100 Year 12 places for September 2015. When the sixth form is fully established, there will be 200* sixth form students on roll.

The Governing Body will implement the proposal.

* The capacity of the sixth form will be 200 students in total. Whilst the majority of places may be taken up by the students already on the roll of the school, an admission number of 20 places will be set for new entrants to the sixth form, by students from outside of the school
