## 1.1 Description of Object/Objects

Bed settee, 1930s, which converts into a double bed, one wooden arm contains shelves and a small table. Measures 90 cm x 64 cm. Accession number 1983/812. Acquired in 1982. Donor name known, but no contact details recorded.





#### 1.2 Reason For Disposal

It is recommended that this item is disposed of for the following reasons:

- The bed settee is in poor condition, with main parts missing. It is beyond the Service's ability to conserve or repair it.
- The bed settee has not been on display, used, or assisted in helping with public enquiries or research in the last 10 years. It is an under-used item.

# 1.3 Suggested Means of Disposal & Reason

It is recommended that the item is offered to other Accredited museums as a gift or transfer. If not required by another museum another appropriate home should be found within the public domain, e.g. school or university.

## 1.4 Impact Statement

- **1.4.1 Potential Risks** negative publicity due to condition of the bed settee. According to its records it was complete when accessioned.
- **1.4.2 Potential Benefits** increased space in Butterworths Store for remaining collection and future acquisitions and improved care for remaining collections.
