Subject:	White Paper 'Healthy Lives, Healthy People: Our Strategy for Public Health in England' - Impact on Partnership Working in Children's Services	

Summary:

The White Paper "Healthy Lives, Healthy People: Our Strategy for Public Health in England" is currently passing through the parliamentary process. This paper accompanies a presentation to this Scrutiny Committee which describes the changes proposed in the White Paper and the possible impact on partnership working with Children's Services.

Actions Required:

To receive the update and agree any further exploration or preparation work required.

1. Background

The Coalition Government has introduced wide ranging new legislation to enable reform of the National Health Service (NHS).

The overarching White Paper on Social Care is making its way through Parliament currently and national and local agencies are planning for the significant changes and responsibilities the Bill represents.

The presentation at Appendix A is designed to stimulate debate and raise awareness amongst Children and Young People Scrutiny Committee members.

2. Conclusion

New legislation is almost guaranteed to achieve passage into law and require significant changes to organisations' roles and responsibilities.

Local agencies need to understand and prepare for these changes in roles, influencing them wherever possible.

3. Consultation

As information only item, no consultation has been carried out locally. However, significant national consultation was undertaken prior to legislation being introduced.
