- Offering multiple vocational pathways for progression to apprenticeships and direct employment.



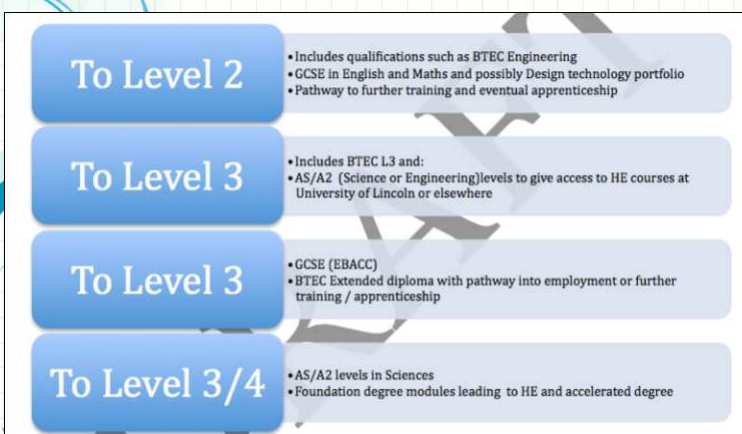

- A 4 term year over 40 weeks structured around a working day between 0830 and 1700



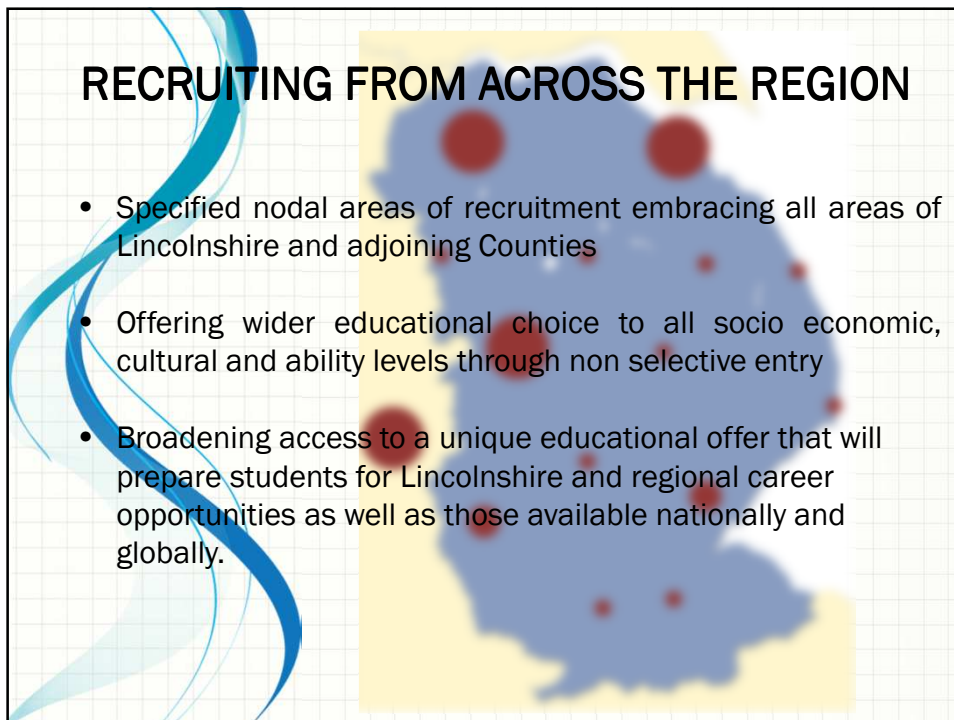
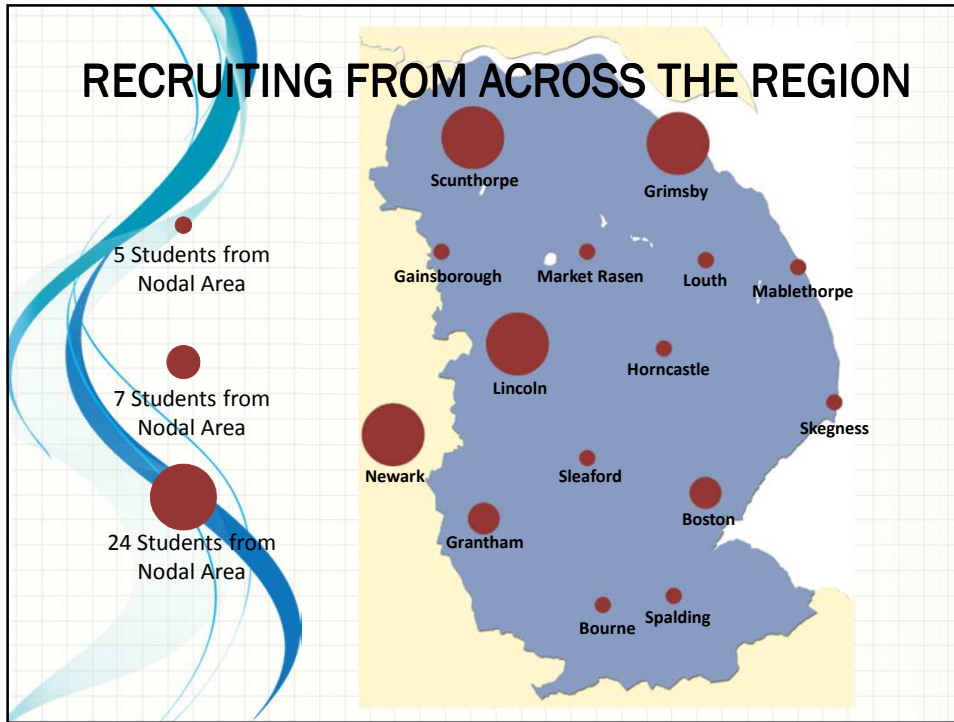
LOCATED IN CENTRAL LINCOLN

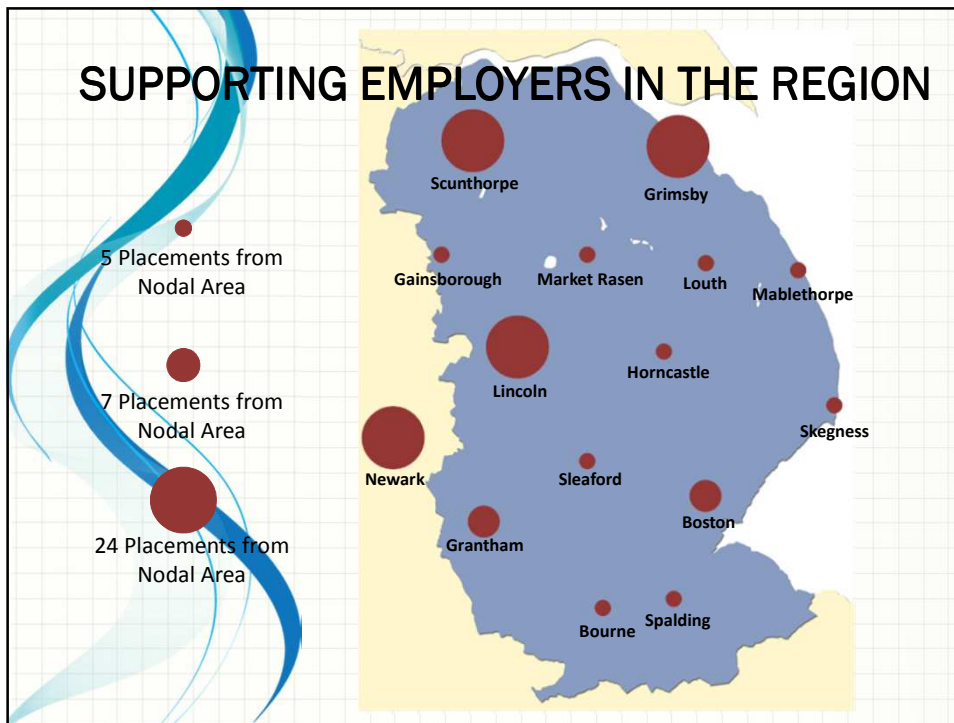


- The Greystone Building, Lindum Road, Lincoln
