









Beach Recycling at Winthorpe

- Nearshore too shallow for dredger
- Accumulation on sand bar
- Rapid response
- 63,000m3 moved in 2 weeks





Additional Works

- Outfall repairs
- Replacement of navigation markers



Inspecting the tidal defences



- Many of the defences constructed after 1953
- Refurbished in the 1980's
- Buried under sand in 1990's
- Will inform future works
- Next steps March 2021











Weed cutting was completed mid September to get the roots out of the middle of the river ready for dredging.

Steeping Steering Group Chair Robert Caudwell, centre, is with local councillors from the partnership, Joe Taylor and Wendy Bowkett, near Bycroft's Bridge at the start of the dredging.

This is a lagoon similar to those that have been constructed so the dredged material can settle – the water will run into nearby drains and silt eventually be mixed into the land.



Additional flood risk activity within the Catchment Action Plan includes reducing bank erosion through 'toe protection work' e.g. using coir rolls shown here.


