Local Residents – A further 3 representations have been received since the supplementary report was completed. These do not raise any new issues than those already captured in the Committee papers.

Item 5.2

Planning Manager – Request that a further condition is imposed to ensure the traffic signage set out in the application documents is undertaken and retained for the duration of the development.

16. Notwithstanding the details contained within 'The Construction Traffic Management Plan' approved in condition 12 above, the signage illustrated in Drawing No. 3299(2) PO5 Rev A – 'Site Entrance Detail & Sightlines' shall be erected and shall be retained and maintained for the duration of the development.

Reason: In the interests of the safety of users of the public highway and the safety of users of the site.

Local Residents - A further 56 representations have been received and have raised the following issues (summarised):-

Consideration should be given to alternative green/renewable energy producing options;

Adverse impacts on the Local Wildlife site and 19 similar sites within 2km and other delicate ecosystems;

The ecological assessment was deficient and omitted many species;

The site is too close to the River Bain with a risk of contamination of the river;

The consultation was too limited and should have included neighbouring parishes;
and

The applicants are only interested in profit and not the land.
