

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO HOLD PART OF AN EXECUTIVE MEETING IN PRIVATE

THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012

Pursuant to Paragraph 5 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given of the intention that part of the meeting of the Executive on 5 May 2020 will be held in private.
