## 1. House of Commons Health and Social Care Select Committee – Inquiry into NHS Dentistry

The House of Commons Health and Social Care Select Committee has been conducting an inquiry into NHS dentistry. On 25 April 2023, Sarah Fletcher, the Chief Executive Officer of Healthwatch Lincolnshire (HWL), provided oral evidence to the Committee. Sarah Fletcher stated that HWL received comments from patients each day on the lack of NHS dentists in Lincolnshire, and comments on dental services represented at least 50% of the feedback received by HWL.

Sarah Fletcher referred to travel as a major challenge in Lincolnshire; and the need for more NHS dentists, as well as the possible prioritisation of certain groups, such as pregnant women, children and young people, cancer patients, people with long-term health conditions, and people with disabilities. In addition, health inequalities were exacerbated by the costs of NHS dental treatment. Sarah Fletcher also referred to the centre for dental development in Lincolnshire, and the importance of recruiting and retaining dentists in the county.

## 2. Andrew Morgan, Chief Executive of United Lincolnshire Hospitals NHS Trust
